If you have lived in the Milton Keynes Unitary Authority area for the past 12 months and you are either an emerging or aspiring artist with the desire to develop your skills and artistic career, then you may be eligible to apply. The bursary is available to artists working in any medium.

As the successful artist, you will be able to use the award for equipment, materials, space, facilities, training, travel or even living costs. If you wish, the award can help enable you to reduce your hours of employment to allow you to focus on developing your art work/career.

The successful artist will be able to use the funds for materials, tools and/or training.
